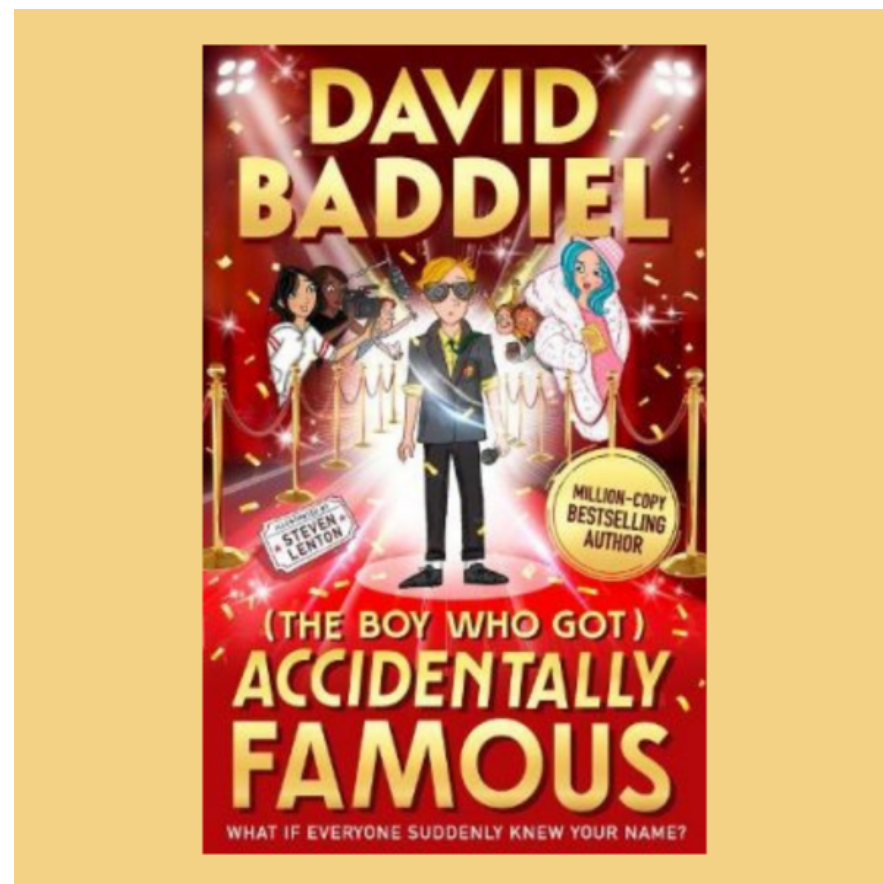

The Boy Who Got Accidentally Famous

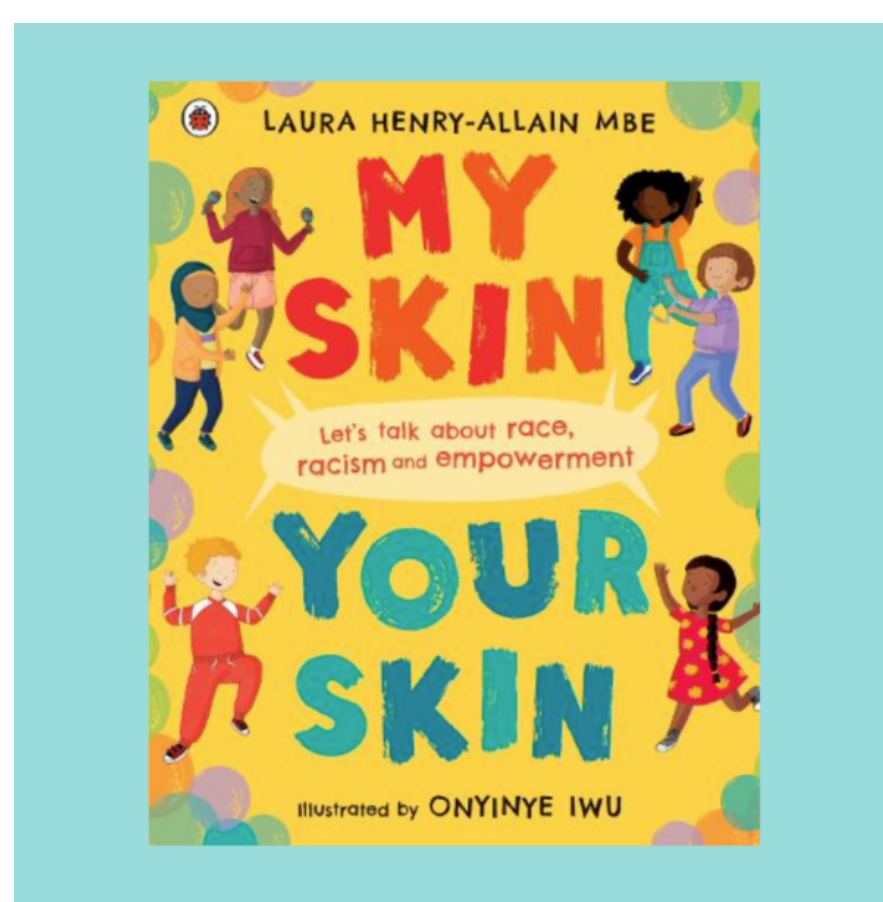
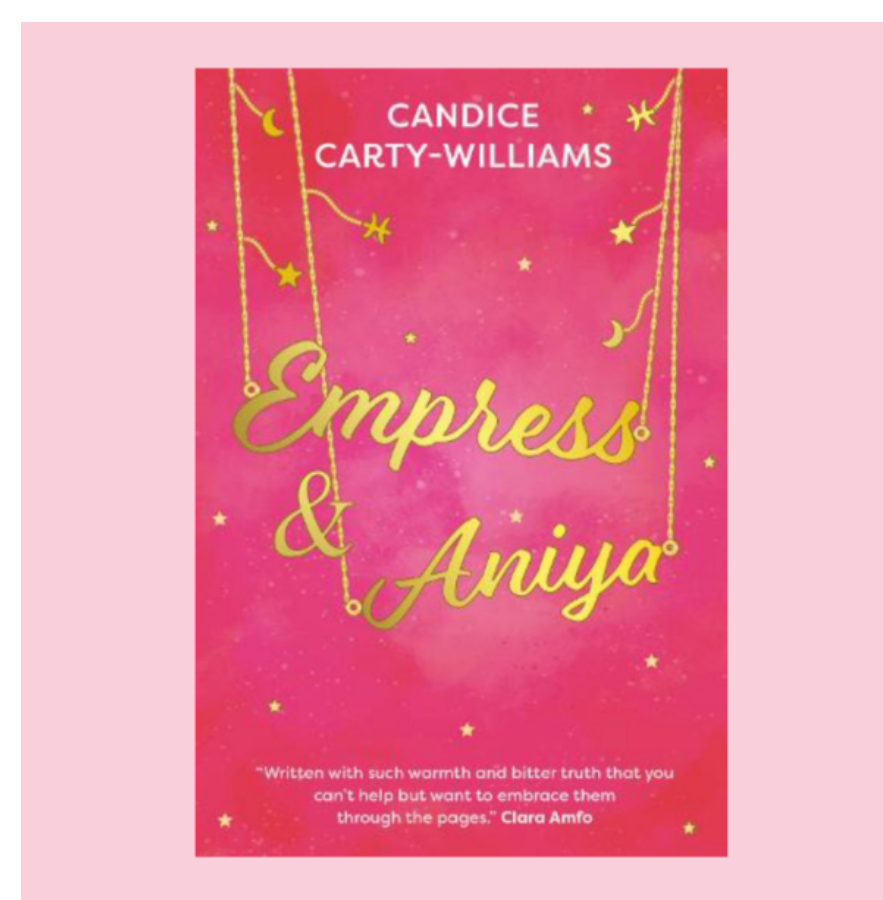

My Skin, Your Skin

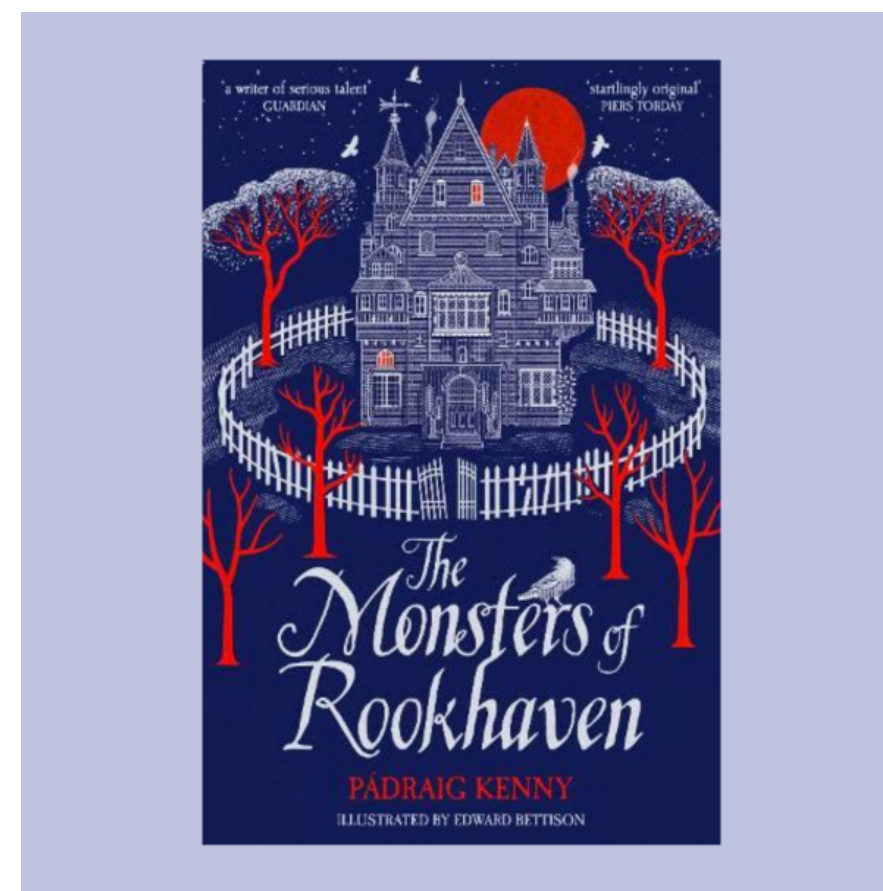
By Laura Henry-Allain, £9.99
